“Now is the time for us to get together and fight for what we need in our D.C. union contract. The more officers there are, the stronger we will be at the bargaining table.

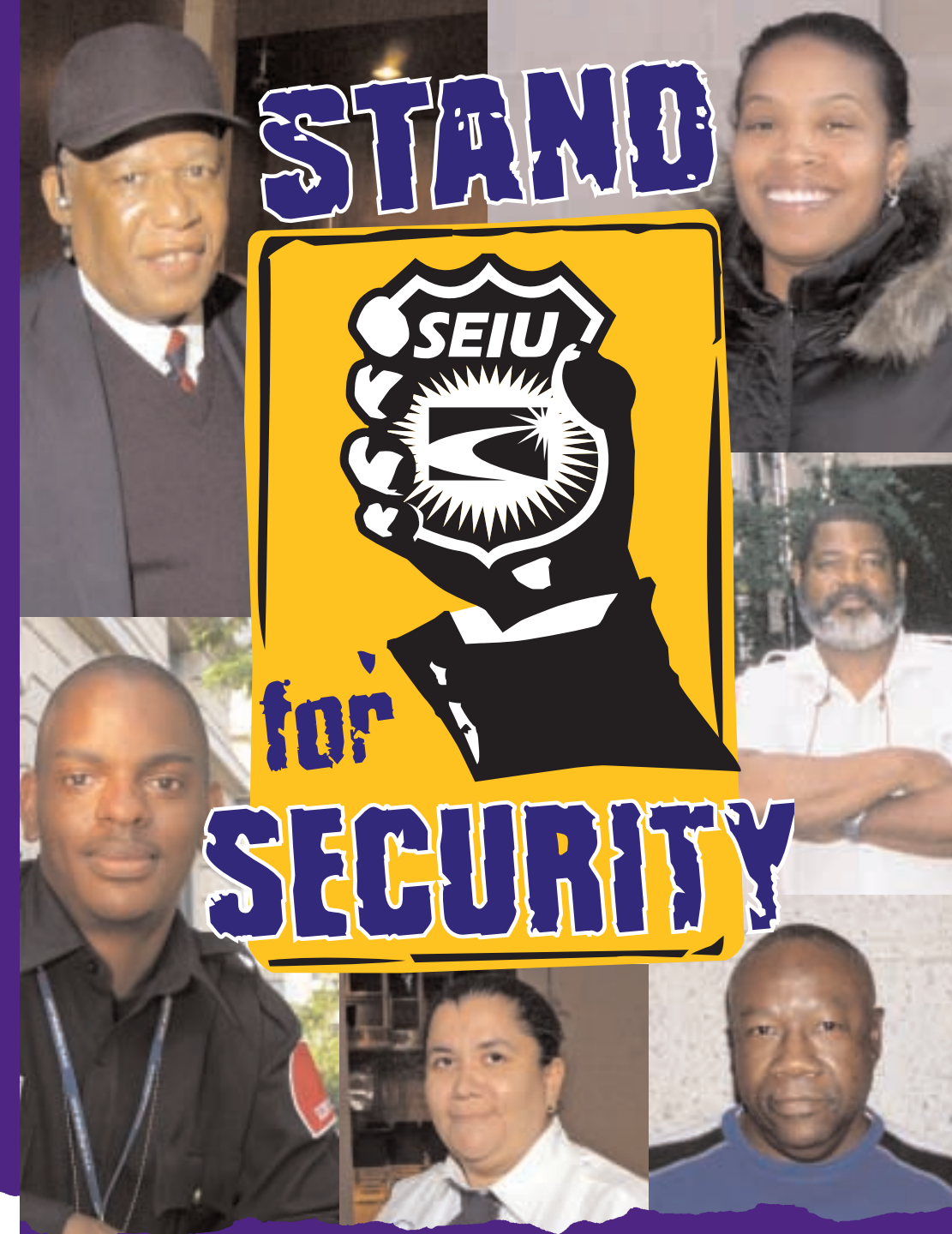
