“On \$7 an hour, I struggle to make ends meet and sometimes must choose between putting food on the table and paying the rent.”



Ana Lopez works as a non-union cleaner at an office building in suburban Philadelphia. She gets no health care coverage, sick days, vacation or paid holidays.

“After joining the union, I make \$12.66 an hour and get health care coverage, personal days and two weeks vacation.”



Maria Baez works as a union cleaner in an office building in downtown Philadelphia. Seven years ago, she made \$8 an hour with no benefits -- that was before cleaners joined together to fight for their rights.

Until now, the American Dream has been out of reach for Ana Lopez and more than 3,000 men and women who clean office buildings in suburban Philadelphia. But today, they are joining together in a campaign to improve working conditions and make the dream a reality.
