**LOCAL 32BJ ENDORSES
MARK GREEN FOR ATTORNEY GENERAL**

New York, NY – Citing Mark Green’s record on fighting for working families as Public Advocate, lawyer and Consumer Affairs Commissioner, Local 32BJ today announced their endorsement of Mark Green for Attorney General of New York State. The announcement, made today at City Hall by Local 32BJ President Mike Fishman and 32BJ members, followed a unanimous decision by the union’s Executive Board.

“Throughout his career, Mark has promoted policies to spur job creation, attack unemployment and establish equal access to health care,” said Mike Fishman, Local 32BJ President. “As Attorney General, he will be a strong advocate for all working New Yorkers.”
