WASHINGTON, DC—Citing Adrian Fenty’s record of fighting for working families, Local 32BJ today endorsed the councilman for mayor of Washington, D.C. The announcement followed a candidate screening by 32BJ members and a unanimous decision by a panel of members.

“Throughout his tenure as councilman, Adrian Fenty has fought hard to pass legislation to protect displaced workers and improve training for security officers,” said 32BJ Vice-President Valarie Long. “As mayor, he will be a strong advocate for all working people in Washington, D.C.”

“Local 32BJ fights for the issues most important to D.C.’s working families and I’m honored that they’re standing with me and my campaign,” said Fenty. “I look forward to working with the men and women of Local 32BJ as we fight to make the District of Columbia a place where all workers receive the health care and wages they need and deserve.”
