MPOS Make Politics Work!

What is the Member Political Organizer Program?

The Member Political Organizer (MPO) program gives members who have demonstrated a level of commitment to the union's political program, the opportunity to work as a full time political organizer during the election season. MPOs are Local 32BJ members who promote our political program. They are trained to be forceful advocates for the cause of building service workers and all working families. They work on the front lines of our struggle to make politics work for working people.

What does an MPO do?

MPOs are political activists who also energize other members into getting politically involved. They work at job sites, on the phones, and in their neighborhoods to:

- ★ Talk to members about their political concerns
- ★ Register members to vote and get out the vote on Election Day
- ★ Recruit volunteers
- ★ Pressure politicians and build community support on our issues
- ★ Organize and coordinate phone banks
- ★ Increase our American Dream Fund membership to support the political work and carry out the political program of our Union.

MPO Training and Development

The local 32BJ political department will provide leadership training and organizing skills to effectively organize members and coordinate activities in the following areas:

- ★ Phone bank
- ★ Volunteer recruitment
- ★ Delivering message and persuasion to voters
- ★ GOTV and Election Day activities
